Wednesday 20 July marked the 53rd anniversary of the first man landing on the moon, so we were keen to celebrate the day here at Lulworth House Residential Care Home.


Our residents enjoyed watching a short **video clip of the landing** and flicking through pictures and articles from the newspaper, regarding this important step for humanity.
